SUMMARY

Design and operation of the B.C.U.R.A. down-jet steam generator are described. Operating experience gained with a small prototype unit and studies of other types indicate that there should be a wide market for small solid-fuel-fired automatic steam generators, provided the first cost can be kept low.
