MEMBERSHIP

Those with qualification or experience in mining engineering, science or technology can apply for Corporate membership as outlined below. Non-Corporate memberships are available to a wider public.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Honorary Fellows

Honorary Fellows are elected by the Council and normally are those who have distinguished themselves by their attainments, or who have contributed to the advancement of mining or other branches of technology.

Fellows

Fellows of the North of England Institute of Mining and Mechanical Engineers must be over 30 years of age and either;

- A. Have some professional qualifications or certifications in mining engineering as well as at least five years of relevant experience or,
- B. Be someone whose position or attainments in science and technology warrant their election as a fellow. This is the decision of Council.

Fellows may use the title FNEIMME to describe their membership of the Institute.

The cost of Fellowship is £33 annually.

Members

Members must be over 25 years of age and must be working towards the qualifications needed to become a Fellow of the Institute. The Council will from time to time prescribe which examinations Members are required to pass.

The cost of Membership is £33 annually.

Non-Corporate Members

Associate Members

Associate Members shall comprise of persons of not less than 23 years who in the opinion of the Council must at the time of his candidature be engaged in mining engineering or an ancillary branch thereof or in a science associated therewith and shall satisfy the Council that they are in the process of qualifying as a Corporate Member or otherwise approved by the council and shall have passed such examinations as the Council may from time to time prescribe.

The cost for Associate Membership is £27.50 annually.

Students

Shall comprise of persons who are in the process of qualifying for the profession of mining engineering or a field related to mining. Such person may continue as a Student until they attain the age of 25 years while they continue to study.

The cost for Student Members is £27.50 annually.

ASSOCIATE member

Membership as an Associate member is open to any person who desires to promote and advance the science, history, research and practice of mining and holds a position, which, in the opinion of the Council renders them eligible for Associate Membership.

The cost of Associate membership is £27.50.
